

### The Mothers Board History

In 1997, it was revealed to Pastor McCree and Rev. Thomasina Owens to bring together Senior Women of the Church to formulate a Mother's Board. The first meeting was held at the home of Mother Mary Riley. At this meeting the qualifications for a Mother were established; they would be Age 60 and older with love, patience, confidentiality, kindness, have been a mother, and a humble spirit to name a few.

Our second meeting was held at the Church and first officers were elected: Mother Essie Mobley, President; Mother Kate Griffin, Vice-President; Mother Carolyn Hendrix, Secretary; Mother Delores James, Treasurer; Rev. Corrine Lunsford, Chaplain; Mother Elizabeth Pugh, Assistant Chaplain; Mother Catherine Priester, Co-Communication Coordinator; Mother Mae Gibson, Co-Communication Coordinator; Mother Patricia Bell, Program Co-Chairman; Mother Viola Curry, Program Co-Chairperson; Rev. Thomasina Owens, Coordinator.

In 1998, we held our First Women in White Program and Fellowship Tea. The Mother's Board was able to present over \$1,800 towards the Church's Building Fund.

Our First President Mother Essie Mobley relocated to Coco, Florida, several years ago, and later settled in Seattle, Washington. She has since returned to Rochester, NY and our Mother's Board. The Mothers Board continues to be a faithful and committed ministry under the support and guidance of our current Pastor Rev. Dr. Richard Douglass.
