The food pantry is open and free to the public two days per week: **Tues & Thurs. ~ 11am-2pm**. Families can visit the pantry **once per month** and shop free of charge. You can receive 3 days worth of groceries which is a value of over \$100 which will stretch your grocery budget and free up money so that it can be redirected to other bills such as gas and rent. **We service families in the Rochester City School District, Monroe and Wayne Counties and anyone who is in need of food.**

Zion Hill Food Pantry uses the **Client Choice Model**. Clients fill out an informational sheet, is given a bag, and they choose items from our shelves and fresh fruits and vegetables table. We are staffed with friendly, caring volunteers who are here to assist you. **One time ID is required for every member of the household**. Children are not be permitted to shop, but are welcome to sit and wait as their parents shop.

Social Workers may pick up food for their clients with their ID. Please the church office in advance for smooth shopping.
